Timing and Structure

Program begins

<i>Spring session</i>	<i>1 week</i>	Friday, March 14 – Friday, March 21, 2008
<i>Summer session</i>	<i>2 weeks</i>	Sunday, July 20 – Saturday, August 2, 2008
<i>Fall session</i>	<i>1 week</i>	Friday, October 24 – Saturday, November 1, 2008

End of first year

2008-2009 students will have:

- a) obtained approval for their projects, practicum
- b) reached agreement/begun Mentoring Plan
- c) completed first of 2 years of classes

2nd year begins

2008-2009 students begin 2nd Year
2009-2010 students begin 1st year

<i>Summer</i>	<i>2 weeks</i>	July – August 2009 (dates tbd)
<i>Fall</i>	<i>1 week</i>	October – November 2009 (dates tbd)

End of 2nd Year

2008-2009 students will have:

- a) completed 2 years of classes, Mentoring Plan
- b) target dates for completion of Projects, Practicum

2009-2010 students will have:

- a) obtained agreement for Projects and Practicum
- b) reached agreement/begun Mentoring Plan
- c) completed first of 2 years of classes

Certification requirements include successful completion of:

1. The entire two year Program. Four weeks each year, for two years
2. Two Projects:
 - a) Institutional – relates to the student's work
 - b) Self-development
3. Mentoring Plan
4. Practicum
